RESOLUTION # 2021-03-01


WHEREAS, Delaware Township has a responsibility to maintain safe and passable roadways during snow, ice, and inclement weather events for the purpose of travel of its residents, visitors, and emergency equipment; and

WHEREAS, Delaware Township uses various types of vehicles and equipment to ensure that roadways are open to the Delaware Township right-of-way boundaries; and


WHEREAS, it is a privilege for a Delaware Township resident to place a mailbox at the direction of the United States Postal Service regarding height and distance in the Delaware Township right-of-way for the purpose of receiving deliveries from the United States Postal Service and other delivery entities;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Delaware Township will only compensate the owner of the mailbox if Delaware Township physically strikes the mailbox with any of Delaware Township's vehicles or equipment to a reasonable cost of the condition of the damaged mailbox. Delaware Township will not compensate the owner of the mailbox if the damage occurred by the weight of the snow, ice, or other inclement weather striking the mailbox due to the process of removing such precipitation from the roadway.

ENACTED this 1st day of March, 2021, by the Board of Supervisors of Delaware Township, Northumberland County, PA. Said Resolution shall become **EFFECTIVE** on the 1st day of March, 2021.


